

In the course of the hearing, the complainant withdrew his complaint, with the agreement that the respondents would determine the cost of transcribing the requested recording that contained the home telephone number of the retired chief of police, with only the phone number redacted, advise the complainant of the cost, and provide the transcript(s) if paid for.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based on the withdrawal of the complaint, the case is dismissed.
