Thereafter, on the record, the complainant and respondent requested a postponement of the hearing in order to continue their settlement discussions. The request for postponement was granted.

On March 9, 2020, the complainant notified the Commission that the matter had been settled between the parties and he wished to withdraw his appeal. The Commission takes administrative notice of such withdrawal.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based upon the withdrawal, the complaint is dismissed.


