James Rovella, Commissioner, State of Connecticut, Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection; and State of Connecticut, Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and the state's response to it, the hearing was conducted telephonically.¹

After the hearing in this matter was opened, the complainant stated on the record that he wished to withdraw the complaint.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based upon the withdrawal, the complaint is dismissed.
