The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on September 8, 2023, at which time the respondents appeared, but the complainant failed to appear.


The hearing officer notes that counsel for the respondents appeared with Kraig Gray, Deputy Chief of the Greenwich Police Department, who was prepared to testify in this matter. The respondents represented that they spent several hours preparing for the hearing.

The hearing officer further notes that, on August 9, 2023, the respondents submitted an affidavit averring that they had provided the complainant with a copy of the records at issue in this matter.

The following order is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is dismissed for failure to prosecute.
2. The complainant is admonished for her failure to appear at the hearing, which resulted in a waste of scarce state and municipal resources.


