

The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on November 15, 1977 at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared and stipulated to the following facts:

1. The requested records are public records under §1-18a(d), G.S., except as limited by §1-19(b)(3), G.S.
2. The respondents shall delete the names of witnesses not known and ancillary information such as addresses, telephone numbers, etc.
3. The respondents shall delete the results of special FBI tests but will provide a "Summary of Submission to FBI", which shall include a summary of the evidence submitted and a summary of the results.
4. The respondent city will bear the cost of copying such documents because the complainant is indigent.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the stipulation concerning the above captioned matter:


1. Since the parties have stipulated to compliance satisfactory to the complainant, the complaint is hereby dismissed.
