

The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on December 8, 1981, in conjunction with a case involving the same complainants and respondents, FIC#81-146 at which time the complainants and the respondent commission appeared, stipulated to certain facts, and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint docketed as FIC#81-146.


At the hearing on these two matters, the complainants indicated that their interest was in pursuing the allegations contained in FIC81-146, and that the main purpose in filing their second complaint was to establish a pattern of behavior by the respondents that might enhance the complainants' position regarding their first complaint. After discussion among the parties, the complainants agreed to limit their presentation to the allegations contained in Docket #FIC81-146.
