A Report of Hearing Officer was issued on April 10, 2019. Subsequently, by email filed on May 7, 2019, the complainants withdrew the complaint. The commission takes administrative notice of such withdrawal.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based on the withdrawal of the complaint, the complaint is hereby dismissed.


