- Publication
 - When an agency wants to amend their rules, they request a copy from the Administrative Rules Coordinator
 - Agencies make changes in Word
 - o Documents are loaded into Adobe Frame Maker
 - Adobe Frame Maker is used to create the Idaho Bulletin, which is now completely electronic -- Frame Maker experts files in .pdf format
 - The code is published using a web page created in-house. It is really just a series of .pdf links. The .pdf documents are searchable.
- Miscellaneous
 - Idaho requires approval by their legislative regulation review committee before implantation of a regulation, like Connecticut.
 - The Office of the Administrative Rules Coordinator has three staff members, including the Rules Coordinator himself
 - The Office is within the Department of Administrative Services, an executive branch agency
