- IV. Dr. Paul Appelbaum, Columbia University psychology professor, and R. Traci Cipriano, Yale University psychology professor, present on mandatory reporting, emphasizing that:
 - a. Given the small share of violence attributable to mental disorder (3-5%), policies aimed exclusively at people with mental disorders are unlikely to lead to significant increases in public safety
 - b. Mental health professionals have a common law duty to protect when alerted by a patient of a threat of imminent physical harm
 - c. Statutory exceptions to confidentiality allow for breaching confidentiality and for involuntary admission to a hospital for psychiatric evaluation and treatment
- V. Dr. Lisa Namerow, UCONN professor of psychiatry and pediatrics, and Dr. Stephen Larcen, Hartford HealthCare, present on barriers to access to care, recommending:
 - a. improved reimbursement for child and adolescent impatient care
