

<b>COVERED CONNECTICUT PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY</b>
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Starting July 1, 2021, parents/caretakers, and their tax dependents, must meet the following eligibility requirements to participate in the Covered Connecticut Program:

- Have a household annual income that is greater than 160%, and up to and including 175% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL – chart below)
- Have at least one dependent child in the household under age 19; Children aged 18 must be a full-time student in secondary school.
- Be eligible for Advanced Premium Tax Credits (APTCs) and Cost Sharing Reductions (CSRs)
- Use 100% of Advanced Premium Tax Credits (APTCs) and Cost Sharing Reductions (CSRs) available to them, along with the expanded American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) financial assistance.
- Be enrolled in an eligible Silver Level Plan
