RE: Flood Damage in Danbury Hospital's Interventional Radiology Rooms  
Request for Emergency CON Approval

Dear Commissioner Vogel:

Workmen accidentally damaged a fire system sprinkler head. The water from this damage penetrated to lower floors and caused extensive water damage to radiology equipment in one of the Hospital's two Interventional Radiology Rooms.

The Hospital has been able to operate one of the two rooms, which was only minimally affected. However, all of the equipment in the other room has been determined not to be salvageable, and has been removed by the insurance company.

We are continuing to operate the second room, but urgently need to reopen the closed room.

The original cost of the equipment in the damaged room was \$382,500, which was approved as part of our CON in Docket No. 97-562 (January 8, 1997).

The cost of replacing this equipment is \$844,238 (Siemens Quote dated November 4, 2004).

We consider this replacement to be of an emergency nature. OHCA approval would enable the Hospital to continue to provide vital patient services and to remain in compliance with health, building and life safety codes.

We respectfully request that OHCA consider this an emergency and assist us.

Dear Mr. Eisner:

On November 24, 2004, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your letter regarding the flood damage in Danbury Hospital's Interventional Radiology Rooms as a result of water damage from a fire system sprinkler head. The estimated capital expenditure associated with the proposal requires Certificate of Need authorization pursuant to Section 19a-639b of the Connecticut General Statutes. Your letter has demonstrated that the proposed repairs and replacement of equipment are of an emergency nature. As the capital expenditure associated with the repair and replacement project is necessary for the Hospital to remain in compliance with health, building and life safety codes, OHCA waives the letter of intent timing requirements and hearing requirements.

The CON Application is attached. **When submitting your CON Application, please paginate and date each page contained in your submission. In addition, please submit one (1) original and two hard copies; as well as an electronic copy on CD or Diskette.
