

CONNECTICUT INFORMATION SHARING SYSTEM (CISS)

A comprehensive, state-wide information technology system mandated by state statute CGS § 54-142s, and used by Connecticut Criminal Justice Agencies to share criminal justice information in a secure environment, thereby enhancing the safety of the public and criminal justice community through informed decision-making.

➤ Search

- Allows users to search 14 Criminal Records Source Systems for people, locations, events and property within a single common portal.

➤ Workflow

- Through CISS electronic Information Exchanges, it replaces the majority of the manual delivery of documents and data that occurs today.

 - Apparent target, female, fled scene





CISS AUTOMATED WORKFLOW FOR STATE AGENCIES

- ✓ **SCO** - Manual entry of arrest data no longer required.
- ✓ **DCJ** – Arrest info electronically transmitted into their new Case Management system.
- ✓ **DPDS** – Access to timely information essential for decision making relevant to their clients.

TIMESAVING WITH CISS WORKFLOW

Steps	With CISS	Without CISS
Police Make an Arrest	1 hour	1 hour
Enter Arrest Data into the RMS System	1 hours	2 hours
Prepare paperwork for delivery to Court	90% not required	1 hour
Drive the Paperwork to Court	90% not required	20 mins to 2 hours
At the Courthouse the Clerk Reviews the Paperwork and signs Transmittal List & returns to Officer	90% not required	20 to 30 mins
Officer Returns to PD	Not required	20 mins to 2 hours
Time it takes to review information	< 2 Hours	8 hours per G.A.

POWER OF CISS

- Provides state of the art technology to 13,000 CISS users.
- Accurate, complete, and timely information.
- Improve officer and public safety.
- Automatic electronic notifications.
- Clearinghouse for arrest and misdemeanor summons.
- Reduced time spent on processing time, data entry, correcting data errors & manually seeking information.
- Save an estimated \$15 million* a year through efficiencies.
