Recidivism Syntax File	Jody passed out specific fields of files including:  The Master File The Movement File The Sentencing File The Classification File Screens – how the data appears for a particular inmate Mary's format of the information given to Steve  The Master File includes the name of the inmate, the rest rely on the inmate's DOC number.  Steve and Jody discussed the information provided and how Steve uses it to conduct the recidivism study. Steve further outlined the data that he wants to include in future reports.  Some data categories are incomplete in the wealth of data available. Furthermore, some data is not saved over time, but rather is updates as it changes, which provides limitations for its use in the recidivism study, which tracks the previous three years. In addition, there is difficulty in deterring the time served, if pre-trial time is considered. Pre-trial credits are recorded/granted inconsistently.  Steve requested that 1997 data be sent to him by July 1 so he can work with it and that 2004 data be sent by September 15, but run no earlier than September 1.	Mary will email her contacts at the 6 other uniform states (no separation of jail and prison) to determine how they track their pre-trial data.  They will investigate creating a uniform sentence type grouping.  Doc will provide CT SAC with the following additional data:  Security Risk Classification Offense Classification (from parole to DOC system)  Education level (to compare to the risk level which incorporates education)  Jody and Mary will attend the SAC meeting on July 3 to discuss the 1997 data that will be sent to Steve.  Linda will send emailed data requests to DOC stating the due dates for each data set.
