

Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program

OPTION C: All Local PDs

February 2, 2017

Funds are distributed to towns with organized police departments based on two-year violent crime rate.

***Allocations are adjusted down for seventeen towns that received Direct Local JAG awards (these are funds awarded through DOJ directly to CT higher crime jurisdictions)**

According to federal program regulation, the State must distribute \$1,767,000 JAG Variable Pass-Through (JAG VPT) Funds and \$511,460 LT10K funds to local governments.

Represents three years of federal JAG awards (FY14, 15 and16).
