
Pursuant to Section 32-9j of the Connecticut General Statutes, I am providing you with the 2022 Connecticut Distressed Municipalities list. The Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) has designated the following twenty-five communities as “distressed”:

The above municipalities received this designation based upon their ranking in the areas of per capita income, change in per capita income, the percentage of poverty in the population, the change in population between 2010 and 2020, the change in employment between 2011 and 2021, the unemployment rate, the percentage of housing stock built before 1939, the percent of adults age 25 and older with a high school degree or higher and the adjusted equalized net grand list per capita.
