EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 8

**WHEREAS**, a declaration of civil preparedness emergency was issued by the Governor on August 25, 2011 due to the severe weather conditions predicted to affect the state as a result of Hurricane Irene;

**WHEREAS**, Connecticut General Statutes section 28-9(b) authorizes and empowers the Governor to take such steps as are reasonably necessary in light of such emergency to protect the health, safety and welfare of the people of the state, and to modify and suspend in whole or in part, any statute, regulation or requirement or part thereof, whenever the Governor is of the opinion that it is in conflict with the efficient and expeditious execution of civil preparedness functions;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the authority granted by section 28-9(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Governor issued Executive Orders 6 and 7; and


**WHEREAS**, there is no longer a need to continue the state of civil preparedness emergency or keep in force the executive orders issued in accordance with the powers vested in the Governor pursuant to section 28-9(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Dannel P. Malloy, Governor of the State of Connecticut, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the state of civil preparedness emergency declared by the Governor on August 25, 2011 is hereby ended; and**
- 2. That Executive Orders 6 and 7 issued pursuant to the Governor's authority set forth in section 28-9(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes are hereby rescinded.**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
