Declaration

AGENCY: Federal Emergency Management Agency, DHS.

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: This notice amends the notice of a major disaster
declaration for the State of Connecticut (FEMA-4500-DR),
dated March 28, 2020, and related determinations.

DATE: This amendment was issued April 30, 2020.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The notice of a major disaster
declaration for the State of Connecticut is hereby amended
to include Individual Assistance limited to the Crisis
Counseling Program for those areas determined to have been
adversely affected by the event declared a major disaster by
the President in his declaration of March 28, 2020.

Individual Assistance limited to the Crisis Counseling Program for all areas in the State of Connecticut (already designated for emergency protective measures [Category B] not authorized under other Federal statutes, including direct Federal assistance).
