Subject:Police Officer Standards and Training Council Model Policy to Train Drug
Recognition Experts in State Law Enforcement

At the March 10th, 2022 regular meeting, the Police Officer Standards and Training Council adopted a Model Policy to ensure that enough police officers become trained as drug recognition experts (DRE) pursuant to Public Act 21 – 01 (Bill No. 1201), An Act Concerning Responsible and Equitable Regulation of Adult-Use Cannabis (RERACA) <u>2021SB-01201-R00-SB.PDF (ct.gov)</u> Sec.114.(c).

Not later than October 1, 2022, and pursuant to Public Act 21 – 01 (Bill No. 1201, Sec.114(d)), each law enforcement unit shall adopt and maintain a written policy that meets or exceed the standards of the model training policy. <u>Download Model Policy</u>
