SUBJECT: Request for Finance Advisory Committee Action

When an agency needs to transfer funds between state accounts over a certain dollar threshold, it must make a request to the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) that the transfer be considered by the Finance Advisory Committee (FAC).

The Department has requested the following FAC transfer on behalf of the Connecticut Technical Education and Career System (CTECS):

Transfer of funds from the CTECS Personal Services Account \$2,000,000

Transfer of funds to the CTECS Other Expenses Account \$2,000,000
