




# Selecting the Unit for access to NGPF:

#### 1. Select a Unit

The unit will open and the lessons will be listed on the right along with the resource library.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

- Q: Do I need to create an account?
- A: No, but verified teachers who create an account will have access to assessments, answer keys, and more.
- Q: Is there a help center if I want to learn more?
- **A:** Yes. On the GoOpen CT homepage, there are four headings along the top. Select "Learn More" to find the <u>Help Center</u>.
- Q: Is there professional development from NGPF?
- A: Yes, there are three options: 1) Virtual PD; 2) NGPF Certification Courses; and 3) On Demand Teacher PD.
- Q: How many high school course options are there?
- **A:** There are four different options for high school. Visit **Next Gen Personal Finance** and select the arrow button next to the curriculum.
- Q: Can I modify the unit(s)?
- **A:** Users cannot modify in CSDE designed Courses and Units published in GoOpen CT. Users should consult local curricular leaders to understand the district curriculum development process before making decision to modify or adapt. The process for implementation of the CSDE K-8 model curricula is a local decision.
