Art, PreK–12 (#042)

- A subject area major in art (*Note: a subject area major is determined by the institution.*)
- Passing scores on Praxis II – Art (#5135)

Effective January 1, 2019:

NEW Computer Science (Unique Endorsement #110)

- A major in computer science or at least 30 semester hours of credit related to computer science including study in each of the following areas:
 - Computing Systems, which may include devices; hardware and software; troubleshooting
 - Networks and the Internet, which may include cyber security; network communication and organization
 - Data and Analysis, which may include storage; collection; visualization; transformation; inference and models
 - Algorithms and Programming, which may include algorithms; variables; control; modularity/ decomposing; program development
 - Impacts of Computing, which may include culture/history; social interactions

Note: At least 12 semester hours of credit must be specific to computer science.

Dance, PreK–12 (#483)

- A major in Dance or 30 semester hours of credit in Dance

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CROSS ENDORSEMENTS FOR CONNECTICUT EDUCATORS

Health, PreK–12 (#043)

- A major in health or 30 semester hours of credit in health, including a course in each of the following:
 - drug prevention education; and
 - group facilitation.
- Passing score on Praxis II – Health Education (#5551)

Home Economics, PreK–12 (#045)

- A major in home economics or 30 semester hours of credit in home economics
- Passing scores on Praxis II – Family and Consumer Science (#5122)

Music, PreK–12 (#049)

- A subject area major in music
- Passing scores on Praxis II – Music (#5114)

Physical Education, PreK–12 (#044)

- A major in physical education or 30 semester hours of credit in physical education coursework
- Passing score on Praxis II – Physical Education (#5095)

School Library Media Specialist (#062)

- 30 semester hours of graduate credit in school library media

Note: Up to 21 graduate credits may be accepted in educational technology or library science. However, at least nine graduate credits must be specific to school-based coursework in such areas as: teaching students, staff, and faculty to utilize media and its accompanying technology by applying valid instructional methods and techniques; application of principles of administration and supervision for effective leadership and operation of the school library media center program; and formulation of the educational specifications and contribution to the design of school library media facilities.

TESOL, PreK–12 (#111)

- 30 semester hours of credit in TESOL including coursework in each of the following:
 - English syntax and English composition
 - language theory
 - culture and intergroup relations
 - linguistics and academic assessment of limited-English-proficient students
 - curriculum and methods of teaching English as a second language
- Passing score on Praxis II – TESOL (#5362)

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CROSS ENDORSEMENTS FOR CONNECTICUT EDUCATORS

Technology Education, PreK–12 (#047)

Effective July 1, 2018, educators who hold a valid Initial, Provisional, or Professional Educator Certificate with a teaching endorsement may be eligible for an additional endorsement in a designated shortage area by obtaining a passing score on the appropriate Praxis II or ACTFL test(s). Additional coursework in the content area is no longer required.

- Passing scores on Praxis II – Technology Education (#5051)

Theatre and/or Drama, PreK–12 (#485)

- A major in Theatre and/or Drama or 30 semester hours of credit in Theatre and/or Drama

NOTE: All coursework must result in the award of college-level credit posted to an official transcript from a regionally accredited college or university.
