SUBJECT: African American/Black and Puerto Rican/Latino Curriculum and Course Update

The Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) and the State Education Resource Center (SERC) are excited to share the following updates regarding the African American/Black and Puerto Rican/Latino course.

- In accordance with <u>Public Act 19-12: An Act Concerning the Inclusion of Black and</u> <u>Latino Studies in the Public School Curriculum</u>, SERC and the CSDE have been developing the mandated one-credit, year-long high school elective course and curriculum in collaboration with: nine advisory committees; an expert review panel, and a 150-member advisory group representing racially and culturally diverse historians, scholars, high school educators, educational organizations, community and museum representatives, parents, students, and advocates.
- SERC has created the <u>Public Act 19-12: An Act Concerning the Inclusion of Black and</u> <u>Latino Studies in the Public School Curriculum Website</u> to update the educational community on the process and progress of curriculum development, to include <u>DRAFT</u> <u>course description</u> and <u>DRAFT learning objectives</u>.
- The draft African American/Black and Puerto Rican/Latino curriculum will be presented to the State Board of Education (Board) on December 2, 2020, for review and approval.
