The Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) is pleased to continue its partnership with the State Education Resource Center (SERC) to support the effective implementation of the African American/Black and Puerto Rican/Latino Course of Studies. High school educators, including curriculum and department coordinators, who will be implementing the course next year are invited to participate. The series is planned to be a combination of virtual and in-person sessions and will be at no cost to districts with the exception of release time/substitute coverage needed. Each cadre will be capped at 60 schools/registrants to serve the anticipated number of new schools participating. As this training is organized as a professional learning community, it is highly suggested that staff from the same school/district register for and attend the same cadre.
