The Connecticut School Discipline Collaborative will:

4. Develop or identify tools for district and school personnel to implement alternatives to exclusionary discipline.

<sup>2.</sup> Evaluate and recommend plans for statewide school discipline reform initiatives to the State Board of Education;

<sup>3.</sup> Review effective practices carried out in Connecticut and other states to increase alternatives to exclusionary discipline and determine the feasibility of carrying out those practices in this state; and
