# Instructions for Submitting the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP) Grant Application

### Introduction

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP) provides funding directly to schools for use in purchasing a variety of fresh fruits and vegetables to serve to students during the school day. Participating schools can distribute fruits and vegetables in a variety of ways, including kiosks throughout the school, in the classroom, and free vending machines. With the distribution of fresh fruits and vegetables, nutrition education activities are highly encouraged to support the program's goals. The goals of the FFVP are to:

- create healthier school environments by providing nutritious food choices;
- expand the variety of fruits and vegetables children experience;
- increase children's fruit and vegetable consumption; and
- make a difference in children's diets to impact their present and future health.

This document provides instructions for school food authorities (SFAs) on how to submit applications to the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) to participate in the FFVP for school year 2025-26. SFAs must submit this information in the CSDE's Online Application and Claiming System for Child Nutrition Programs (CNP System). Applications are due to the CSDE by **May 2, 2025.**

### 1 — Starting the District Application

- 1. Access the CSDE's Online Application and Claiming System for Child Nutrition Programs (CNP System) at https://ct.cnpus.com/prod/Splash.aspx.
- 2. Log in with your User ID and Password.



3. Select **Applications** from the top navigation bar.




4. Under Item, select FFVP Application Packet.



5. Under **Action**, select **Detail** for school year 2024 – 2025.




6. Select Add next to Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Sponsor Application.




## 2 — Completing the District Application

7. Under **Contact Information**, complete information for numbers 1-4.



8. Under **Certification**, read, agree to, and check box after number 5.



9. When application is complete, click **Save** then **Finish**.

Note: Errors are acceptable until you enter your site applications.

- 10. Decide which sites will submit applications for the FFVP. Before submitting site applications, make sure each site is listed on one of the CSDE's three eligibility lists (refer to "FFVP Eligibility" in the "FFVP Application" section of the CSDE's FFVP webpage).
  - List of Area Eligible Schools for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program;
  - List of Residential Child Care Institution (RCCI) Eligible Schools for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program; or
  - List of Site Eligible Schools for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program.
- 11. Under **Action**, select **Add** for the specific site.

12. Complete questions 1-12 for each Site Application and edit questions 13-16 if necessary.

- 13. Upload your signed FFVP Application Certification form, which includes the nondiscrimination statement (refer to section 5). Digital signatures are acceptable.
  Note: If you bundle all sites into one PDF scan, you may upload the same file under each site.

- 14. When complete, click **Save** and **Finish**.
  - a. Select **Save** at the bottom of the Site Application:




b. Select Finish:




15. Repeat steps 10-13 until all sites submitting applications for the FFVP are complete.
