## Connecticut Technical Education and Career High Schools Students

<b>E.C. Goodwin Tech (New Britain)</b>	New Britain	The town where the student lives provides transportation

<b>Howell Cheney Tech (Manchester)</b>	East Hartford or Manchester	The town where the student lives provides transportation
	Hartford or New Britain	<b>RSCO Transportation</b> provides transportation

When the Student Registers	When the Student's Transportation Starts
<b>Register before July 1<sup>st</sup></b>	Transportation usually starts on the student's first day of school.
<b>Register after July 1<sup>st</sup></b>	Transportation may not start on the student's first day of school. Parents/guardians should plan to transport their child to and from school until transportation starts.
<b>Returning students</b>	If a student's address is the same as last school year, transportation should start on the student's first day of school.
	If student's address has changed since last school year, the start transportation may not start on the student's first day of school. Communicate any changes to your school as soon as possible because your child may need to be assigned to a different bus stop.

### Additional Information

Students are generally assigned to centralized bus stops, which are in or near the student's town, often in a public place, and most likely, not within walking distance from the student's home. Families are notified of their child's specific transportation information, including:

- the start date
- bus stop location
- drop-off/pick-up times
- if the school participates in after-school transportation

School districts are required to provide reasonable and necessary transportation for their resident students enrolled in a Connecticut Technical High School up to \$6,000 transportation costs per student in the school year. Contact your local town/school region's superintendent's office to arrange transportation services. Parents/guardians denied transportation by their school district may appeal.
