Hartford	Hartford	Parents/Guardians provide transportation
Outside of Hartford	Hartford or Outside of Hartford	Parents/Guardians provide transportation to and from the magnet school and are eligible to receive a \$5 per day reimbursement that is based on the student's attendance and is mailed during the summer months. To receive the reimbursement, parents/guardians must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• transport their child for the entire school year, <b>and</b> complete the on-line reimbursement form found at <a href="http://www.crec.org/transportation/forms.php">www.crec.org/transportation/forms.php</a>, before June 15<sup>th</sup>.</li> </ul>

When the Student Registers	When the Student's Transportation Starts
Before July 1 <sup>st</sup>	Transportation usually starts on the student's first day of school.
After July 1 <sup>st</sup>	Transportation may not start on the student's first day of school. Parents/guardians should plan to transport their child to and from school until transportation starts.
Returning students	If a student's address is the same as last school year, transportation should start on the student's first day of school.  If student's address has changed since last school year, transportation may not start on the student's first day of school. Communicate any changes to your school as soon as possible because your child may need to be assigned to a different bus stop.

## Additional Information

Students are generally assigned to centralized bus stops, which are in or near the student's town, often in a public place, and most likely, not within walking distance from the student's home.

Families are notified of their child's specific transportation information, including:

- the start date
- bus stop location
- drop-off/pick-up times
- if the school participates in after-school transportation
