**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

1. Did the Board deny and/or fail to offer a free appropriate public education (“FAPE”) for the 2018-19 school year?
2. If the Board failed to offer Student FAPE for 2018-19 school year, is Trinity Pawling School the appropriate program?
3. If the Board did not provide and/or fail to offer the Student FAPE for 2018-19 school year, should the Student be reimbursed for the tuition and related expenses of Trinity-Pawling School?

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:**

The Parents filed the Due Process Hearing Complaint on July 30, 2018. The Hearing Officer was appointed on July 30, 2018. The Parents withdrew their complaint with prejudice on September 6, 2018.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is DISMISSED with prejudice.
