## **Holistic Scoring:**

Variety: A range of errors includes sentence formation, punctuation, capitalization, grammar usage, and spelling.

**Severity:** Basic errors are more heavily weighted than higher-level errors.

**Density:** The proportion of errors to the amount of writing done well; this includes the ratio of errors to the length of the piece.
