VOTERS HAVE UNTIL MONDAY SEPT. 11TH AT NOON TO REGISTER FOR PRIMARIES
31 Communities will hold municipal primaries on Tuesday Sept. 11

HARTFORD – Secretary of the State Denise Merrill reminded voters today that those eligible to vote and who wish to register to vote in time for the primaries have until 12:00 p.m. on Monday September 11th to register in person at their local Registrar of Voters office. Unaffiliated voters also have until 12:00 p.m. on Monday to enroll in a major party if they want to vote in that primary in their city or town.

Secretary Merrill said, “If your town is having a primary this Tuesday, make sure your voice is heard! If you think you are already registered to vote, or just aren’t sure, please go to myvote.ct.gov/lookup to make sure your registration is up to date.”

Polls will be open from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. for municipal primaries in 31 communities on Tuesday September 12th. Voters can check their registration status and find their polling place at <http://myvote.ct.gov/lookup>.
