We expect the Sandy Hook tragedy to have long-term impacts on the mental health of Sandy Hook's and Newtown's citizens. To help alleviate this need, we plan to distribute funds to community-based organizations that provide mental health services to Newtown and Sandy Hook community members. We are not limiting our reach to those individuals who were at the school on 12/14/2012. Our plan is to provide assistance for members of the community at large as well as those directly impacted.
