In writing this letter, I represent the Attorney General in his statutory charge to “represent the public interest in the protection of any gifts, legacies or devises intended for public or charitable purposes.” Conn. Gen. Stat. § 3-125. The Office of the Attorney General (“OAG”) has some additional questions for the Community Foundation of Greater New Britain, Inc. (“Foundation”) in connection with the Crombie Law Report on Erin Stewart’s use of the City of New Britain’s credit card. We believe that the Foundation may have documents that will allow us to better understand the facts of the case.


To that end, would you please respond to the following questions and requests for production by June 30, 2026. These questions and requests for production relate to the Time Frame of January 1, 2020, to the present.

1. Please describe the origination, nature, and charitable purpose of the Mayor’s Trophy Charitable Fund (the “Fund”) that is held by the Foundation.
2. Please provide copies of any organizational documents regarding the establishment of the Fund or its charitable purpose.
3. Please describe the process by which distributions are made from the Fund.
4. Please describe the origination and purpose of Financial Account No. **2073320**. (See Attachment 1, check no. 549, account no. **2073320**, identified as “Mayor’s Trophy Charitable Fund.”)
5. Please identify all donations made to the Fund from Financial Account No. **2073320**.

6. Please provide copies of all checks received by the Foundation from Financial Account No. 2073320 in connection with the donations identified in question 5 above.
