The Department of Aging and Disability Services - State Unit on Aging (ADS-SUA) has begun planning activities for the development of the State Plan on Aging for the next three-years (2024-2027).

We anticipate your valued participation in the formulation of the new State Plan and would like your support in spreading the word in your communities as we are seeking increased community participation throughout the State Planning development cycle. Increased participation will allow us to obtain key information that will inform optimal planning of priorities for the state's longterm services and supports system for older adults and their caregivers. We appreciate your partnership as we respond to questions and concerns from the residents in your region to ensure these are reflected in the State Plan.

Finally, there will be a Community Survey distributed via email and hard copies on site to be completed by program participants.
