

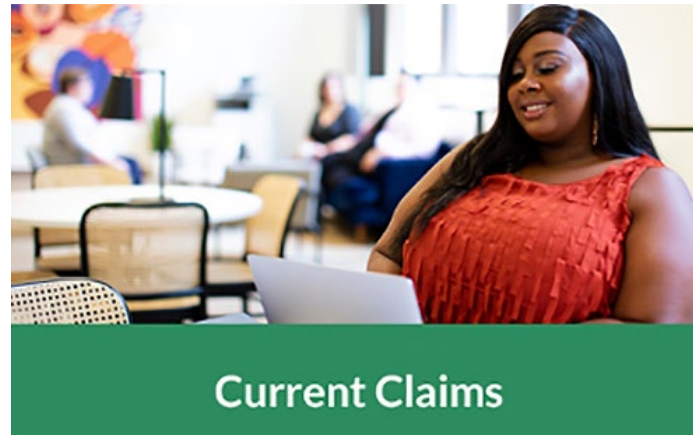


Understanding The Weekly Work Search Requirement

CTDOL requires claimants to do a weekly work search

Filers must report these work search activities online with their weekly certification.



Navigate to your account page through the **GREEN** button
(PRO TIP: Don't bookmark your account pages)

What Counts As Work Search?

Your search for full-time employment can be a combination of activities — at least one of the work search activities must be employer contact.

For example:
