Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2017 Regular Session on July 5:

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HB 7202 PA 17-100	AN ACT ESTABLISHING A DIVISION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION PROGRAMS WITHIN THE TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL SYSTEM. This bill shall take effect from passage.	
HB 7311 PA 17-108	AN ACT CONCERNING LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES AND BUSINESS CORPORATIONS. This bill has various effective dates. Read the text here.	
HB 6012 PA 17-115	AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER PROTECTION IN EYE CARE. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.	
HB 6741 PA 17-119	AN ACT CONCERNING THE RIGHT OF COUNSEL TO ACCESS RECORDS IN CERTAIN ABUSE AND NEGLECT PROCEEDINGS. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.	
HB 6992 PA 17-120	AN ACT PROTECTING THE INTERESTS OF CONSUMERS DOING BUSINESS WITH FINANCIAL PLANNERS. This bill shall take effect from passage.	
HB 7020 PA 17-123	AN ACT REQUIRING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE PROGRAM REVIEW AND INVESTIGATIONS COMMITTEE CONCERNING	

OF LONG-TERM CARE.

This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.

SB 917 PA 17-127	AN ACT CONCERNING DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICES AGAINST VETERANS, LEAVES OF ABSENCE FOR NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS, APPLICATION FOR CERTAIN MEDICAID PROGRAMS AND DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN RECORDS TO FEDERAL MILITARY LAW ENFORCEMENT. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 7132 PA 17-141	AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF NOTICE OF A CLAIM FOR COMPENSATION BY AN EMPLOYEE TO AN EMPLOYER OR A WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSIONER. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
SB 444 PA 17-151	AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH CARE CABINET TO RECOMMEND METHODS TO STUDY AND REPORT ON TOTAL STATE-WIDE HEALTH CARE SPENDING. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 7073 PA 17-182	AN ACT CONCERNING REMEDIES IN LAWSUITS AGAINST PROPERTY OWNERS BY SUBCONTRACTORS AND THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE WITHHELD IN PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS. This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
HB 7156 PA 17-194	AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO STUDENT RECORDS FOR CERTAIN UNACCOMPANIED YOUTHS. This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
HB 7176 PA 17-196	AN ACT CREATING A MILITARY RECRUITMENT RIBBON. This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
HB 6333 PA 17-208	AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN AUTHORITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE RELATING TO THE FOOD SAFETY MODERNIZATION ACT. This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
HB 7221 PA 17-211	AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO WATER PLANNING INFORMATION. This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
HB 7226 PA 17-213	AN ACT CONCERNING AWARDS FROM THE CONNECTICUT ARTS ENDOWMENT FUND. This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
HB 7229 PA 17-214	AN ACT CONCERNING THE CREATION OF CONNECTICUT BROWNFIELD LAND BANKS, REVISIONS TO THE BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION AND REVITALIZATION PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS. This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.

As of this date, the Governor has signed one hundred fifty-three (153) bills of the 2017 Legislative Session.
