Directions to The Lyceum

227 Lawrence St., Hartford

From New Haven and points south (driving I-91 North)

1. Take I-91 north to I-84 West.
2. Follow directions for I-84 West (see below)

From Enfield and points north (driving I-91 South)

1. Take I-91 south to I-84 West.
2. Follow directions for I-84 West (see below)

From northeastern Connecticut, I-91, and points east (driving I-84 West)

1. Take I-84 West to Exit 48 (Asylum Avenue).
2. At the end of the exit, enter the center lane and take a wide right turn onto Asylum Ave. Immediately bear Left onto Farmington Avenue.
3. Follow Farmington Ave. to the first light. Take a left onto Broad Street.
4. Turn right onto Capitol Ave. (the first stoplight after passing the stoplights at the entrance to I-84).
5. At the first stoplight (one block), turn left onto Lawrence Street (Red Rock Café will be on the corner).
6. The Lyceum is about half way down the first block on the right side. It is a large, brick three-story building.
7. Parking is available in the lot just before The Lyceum or on the street (subject to alternate-side-of-the-street parking).

From Danbury, Waterbury, and points west (driving I-84 east)

1. Take I-84 East to Exit 48 (Capitol Ave.).
2. Take a right at the end of the exit ramp onto Capitol Ave.
3. Follow Capitol Ave. to the 3rd traffic light.
4. Take a Left onto Lawrence Street (Red Rock Café will be on the corner).
5. The Lyceum is about half way down the first block on the right side. It is a large, brick three-story building.
6. Parking is available in the lot just before The Lyceum or on the street (subject to alternate-side-of-the-street parking).
