- 1/26/36 - ~~Tree~~ 1 tree alive, 12 ft high, spread 12-14 ft. blooms but no nuts.
- 9/20/39 - Only one tree living, never has borne until this year, has a nice lot of nuts now. No blight.
- 10/25/39 - 50 burrs rec'd, with abortive nuts.
- 2/12/42 - No winter injury - BSC. (over)
- 9/16/44 - Few nuts only. No other chestnut tree nearer than 4 mi. and 1/2 mi. to Chickapin.
