In Feb 1923, Bartlett said 1 mol. fruited when 4 yrs planted, excellent tree & excellent typical mollissima nuts.

Other tree fruited 1922 for first time. Had a round nut, 1 to box. GTG expects that this tree is probably a hybrid between mol. & chinquapin (Lack of pollen - RBC)

Nov. 1923. Dr. B.T.G. reports that of 10 trees sent, 9 are living and in good condition.

Jan. 1934. He advises ^{that} his fine chestnut tree has not missed setting a good crop of nuts a year since it was a couple of years old. The nuts ripen 4 to 6 wks earlier than any ^{the nuts on} other trees over
