5/1/47 - Mr. Jos. O'Fallon
died recently (per C. A. Lee).
Louis Gerardi may carry on
the nursery work.

July 1946 - 26 trees living. Chestnuts have failed
for the last four years; some had a few
nuts, but they were no better than Carr
or Hobson, if as good. Stokes' hybrid and
Hobson are the only ones that had a
fair crop this season.

Jan 1947 - Nut investigations sent Mr. Gerardi:

3/30/43 - Beltsville 418, 464, 563, 751

#418 mostly M₁

not so good. The scions sent
March 19, 43 did not reach destination
(Hemming)
