

#1 Planted 1931 - 10 seedlings were  
planted in this locality - Five are doing  
well - 5 are dead. (am sending remains  
of one tonight that rotted) They made fine  
progress first year. In 1934 they started  
rotting at ground. Soil sandy loam - dry  
in the summer - typical woodland - young  
white pine, white oak, black oak, ash, maple  
& white birch growing in abundance.

#2 Planted 1931 - 30 feet south of seedling  
in #1. Notice how terminal shoot rotted  
& broke off about 2 inches from ground  
between the two healthy shoots. Note that  
the two healthy shoots winter killed &  
rotted off 1934-35 & the new shoots  
that grew last summer, which are healthy  
& budded now. Same conditions apply to this  
seedling as #1 but this one doesn't get as  
much sunlight. J. F. Jones Canton Mass 1936
