The Louis A. Magnarelli Fund commemorates the life and work of Dr. Louis A. Magnarelli. Throughout his career at The Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station, Dr. Magnarelli maintained his unwavering commitment to the Station's motto "Putting science to work for society." Dr. Magnarelli joined the Experiment Station in July 1975 and his work on ticks, tick-associated diseases, and serological testing for vector-borne pathogens are recognized internationally. Through the course of a career that spanned four decades, he served as Chief Entomologist and State Entomologist from 1987-2004, Vice Director from 1992-2004, and was appointed the Station's eighth Director in 2004. As part of Dr. Magnarelli's regulatory responsibilities, he oversaw quarantines on many insect pests, plant pests, and plant pathogens to protect Connecticut. However, he fully recognized the economic impacts these decisions had on citizens and always listened intently to those who voiced their concerns.
