The Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station held its first field day in 1910 and subsequently purchased the first 19.25 acres that today is our 75-acre Lockwood Farm in Hamden, CT. Dr. Stafford will review the history and development of the farm and the changes and improvements over the years to our annual field day.
