SEED GERMINATION AND PURITY ANALYSIS 2016

Seed samples including 250 vegetable seeds, six lawn seeds, and five crop seeds were officially collected by inspectors from the Bureau of Regulation and Inspection of the Connecticut Department of Agriculture and delivered to the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station for testing in 2016. As the official seed testing laboratory, The Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station performed germination and purity analyses of the seed samples for compliance with the Connecticut Seed Law Regulations and the Federal Seed Act. Germination standards were set by the Federal Seed Act or label claims.

The results of germination tests for 250 vegetable seed samples (Table 1) showed that 211 samples (84.4%) passed the test with the germination rates that equaled or exceeded label claims, 18 samples (7.2%) passed the test within allowable tolerance, and 21 samples (8.4%) did not meet their label claims for germination. Among 12 seed companies, one company had all vegetable seed samples pass germination tests, but the other 11 companies had one or more seed samples that did not meet claims of germination (Table 2). Seed samples that did not meet label claims of germination were distributed in 14 of 43 species of vegetables tested (Table 3). Seed samples were examined for prohibited noxious weed seeds and no vegetable samples contained noxious weed contaminants.

A total of six lawn grass seed mixture samples were tested for purity and germination. Since lawn seed samples were labeled with several varieties within a species or a genus, purity and germination results were analyzed as the sum of individuals in a genus. The label claim was met as long as this sum equals or exceeds the sum of the individual components for a genus listed on the label. The results (Table 4) showed that one of the six lawn seed samples met label claims for both purity and germination. The other five lawn seed samples tested contained at least one component which failed to meet the purity or/and germination claims. The three lawn grass seed mixtures that were failed purity tests were due to lower amount of perennial rye, tall fescue, and rough bluegrass, respectively (Table 4). Among three seed components that failed germination tests, two are Kentucky bluegrass, and the other one was creeping red fescue (Table 4). None of the lawn grass seed samples contained seeds of noxious weeds.

Five crop seed samples were tested for purity and germination. The results showed that all five samples met the label claims (Table 5). In the germination tests, three samples passed the standards, two met the label claims within tolerance, and one sample failed the germination test (Table 5). No noxious weeds were identified in the crop seed samples.

Pamela Sletten and Lindsay Patrick performed the seed testing by following the Association of Official Seed Analysts (AOSA) rules. Dr. Yonghao Li completed the analyses and reports. Wayne S. Nelson, Seed Control Official, collected the samples. The Seed Law is administered by the Seed Control Official for the Commissioner of the Department of Agriculture.
