12/4/33 Planted in nursery at Mt Tabor Park. 9 survivors have never been transplanted. Only 18 now alive & 6 of these in poor condition. a few are only 1-2" in diam. & 8-10 ft high. Largest one 4" DBH. & 18ft. high. Planted on poor, shallow dry land, & exposed to cold east winter winds.
