50 Spanish chestnuts, 8-12" DBH, imported from Storrs & Hyersons nursery, Painesville, O. about 1900 as 2-yr.-old seedlings. All thrifty now, except one that has heart rot induced by a fire scar at base

241 American chestnuts, 4-12" DBH, presumably imported from the above nursery at about the same time. All in excellent condition, no signs of ill health

3 Japanese chestnuts, 12" DBH, grown from nuts bought in Vancouver, B.C. All healthy and thrifty

Never has been any mortality among any of the chestnuts
