
RE: Notice of Scoping for Covey Road Water Main Extension DPH Project: 2015-0195 – Town of Burlington

Dear Mr. McPhee:

I have reviewed the Department of Public Health's (DPH's) Memorandum, dated June 4, 2014, regarding the Notice of Scoping for Covey Road Water Main Extension and I offer the following responses to its recommendations:

- 1. The Town of Burlington will consult with the New Britain Water Department (NBWD) to identify the land that is tributary to the Lamson Corners Burlington Brook Reservoir future potential public water supply.
- 2. The Town of Burlington will review the policies of the Growth Management Principle (GMP) #5 (Protect and Ensure the Integrity of the Environmental Assets Critical to Public Health and Safety) of Conservation and Development Policies Plan for Connecticut (2015-2018) and consider the establishment of land use controls over the watershed area that are consistent with said policies.
- 3. The Town of Burlington will consider the establishment of guidelines for evaluating special use permit applications within the future potential public water supply watershed area to ensure that future establishments are constructed, operated and maintained in a manner that is protective of the future potential drinking water supply.
- 4. The Town of Burlington will consider providing an enforceable mechanism that ensures that future land development within the future potential public water supply watershed area adheres to best management practices for the protection of public health.
