Attached please find the Environmental Assessment Summary for the above referenced project. Scoping for the project began on February 3, 2015 and ended on March 6, 2015.

The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) received comments from Department of Public Health (Source Water Protection Unit and Private Well Program) on March 2, 2015. DEEP included a condition in the STEAP funding agreement requiring Newtown to incorporate design and construction measures aimed at meeting DPH requirements. Based on DEEP's environmental assessment and the comments received, it is recommended that an Environmental Impact Evaluation (EIE) is not warranted for this project and that a post-scoping notice to that effect be prepared.
