**Subject:** Lathrop Road Water Main, Plainfield

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In response to my scoping comments dated July 6, 2015, the Town of Plainfield forwarded a Flood Insurance Rate Map revised to reflect a Letter of Map Revision dated December 22, 1993 that substantially reduces the flood zone associated with Mill Brook. The revised map, which was not available on the FEMA Flood Map Service Center website, eliminates the flood plain crossing of Lathrop Road Extension and its encroachment into the undeveloped parcels along the roadway that were referenced in the scoping comments. Therefore, the project will not require certification by DPH as being in compliance with flood and stormwater management standards specified in section 25-68d of the Connecticut General Statutes.
