The Council on Environmental Quality ("Council") offers the following comments regarding Petition 1453.

**State-listed Species**

The Petitioner states that the proposed project is within a Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's ("CT DEEP") Natural Diversity Data Base (NDDDB) buffer area, but indicates that the proposed project does not "necessitate submission of an NDDDB Review Request." The NDDDB maps are intended to be a pre-screening tool to identify potential impacts to state-listed species. Therefore, the Council recommends that the Petitioner seek a determination from NDDDB regarding any precautions that might be needed to protect state-listed species in the area.
