The State Historic Preservation Office has reviewed the information submitted for the above-named pursuant to the provisions of the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act.

Based on the information provided, it does not appear that any of the structures are eligible for listing on the State or National Registers of Historic Places. SHPO believes the structure located at 145 High Street may have been a warehouse associated with the rail line. The demolition of the above listed properties will have no adverse effect on the state's cultural resources.
